# THOUGHT OF THE MONTH

Getting away for the traditional two weeks holiday, while the factory where you work closes for maintenance has now become pretty much extinct as Tyrannosaurus Rex and button up boots. On the other hand the 'Hymn Sandwich' as an expression of worship in churches up and down the land is still as strong as ever it was in Victorian times. If the secular world can move on and adapt to the changing ideas about holidays, life and everything then why is the church of Jesus Christ stuck in the same rut now as it was a hundred years ago? Some people would say that the rut in which the church mainly finds itself is nothing more than a coffin with the ends knocked out. It is in fact just waiting for someone to come and fill in the ends before it can be buried forever.

There may be some who would say best bury the remnants and start again as humanists. In the book of Jeremiah that is pretty much what God had concluded Israel and Judah were saying to Him in their continued refusal to listen to the call to repentance.
