THOUGHT OF THE MONTH

Words cannot really bring home the experiences of people displaced by the war in Syria and Iraq. Some young people living today in that area will never have known peace in their whole lives, war will be their norm. Similarly many people alive today will not have been able to experience Christmas whatever their religion. While the West and the free world run around like headless chooks in the farmyard getting ready for Christmas, this year particularly remember to pray for refugees. Lobby your MP, AM, Minister and anyone else to get action, funds, help for those still stuck in poverty while the soldiers and extremists fight and the politicians argue. Jesus went to where those in need were found, He ministered to their needs, eg feeding 5000, healing the sick and raising the dead. Ordinary people often feel overwhelmed by the rolling news repeating every half hour how many people are killed, displaced, tortured, martyred and generally abused, until it all becomes too much. Ask God to help you see such situations as He sees them, people who He loves and died for in difficulties. Pray that God will help you respond to each situation in an appropriate manner, by prayer, by giving, by going or by volunteering at home.
