# Thought for the Month

Troubles come in many forms. Sometimes they come as a surprise, like when a cat runs out in front of your car, and you are grateful to not have been rammed in the rear. Bad news can come in an official communication, like a tax demand, or bad news in a letter. People bring things which one would rather not hear, people in trouble, accidents, deliberate evil actions and many others. Abram received bad news when his nephew was carried away by bandits. Abram had to get his guys and go and sort them out. (Gen 14:11-16). Sometimes sorting out the bad things in life can be done oneself, sometimes you need a little help from a friend, sometimes only God can help.

When praying this month think of some of the bad situations you have knowledge about, e.g. refugees in Europe & the Middle East. Ask God to raise up solutions. take personal and other problems, and plead for God to send grace into seemingly intractable situations. Pray for peace in the wars around the world, pray for someone who is very sick, ask mercy for those deep in sin, and help for those in bondage or other difficult places. Let us pray for those in trouble this month.
