# Thought for the Month

Does collecting things count as a distraction from God? Taking pride in a pet can bring great satisfaction, yet is this something which leads away from God? There are many things which are bad for you if the doom mongers are to be believed: full fat cheese, animal fats, chocolate, heroin, cocaine, or sniffing glue. Sometimes it is necessary to make a judgement about to extent you get involved what with something. There are recognised medical conditions for people who get carried away with things which can become detrimental to health, for example religious mania. Jesus called His disciples to leave everything and follow where He led them: 'and immediately they left the boat and their father and followed him', (Matt 4:22). So is Jesus asking people today to do the same? To some the answer will be 'yes', while for others it will be 'no'. Some will be called to full or part time ministry, others to just get on with life.

Knowing where to draw the line in being involved with something and where to get in deeper depends on each person. To one person God may say: 'go and get involved in Friday night ministry on the streets of Cardiff picking up the drunks'. To another God may say: 'you are to pray every Friday for that Street Pastor, because you are his spiritual powerhouse, without you his ministry will fail'. God calls each individual to a particular ministry which needs spiritual maturity to see, without the collection, the pet, the cause or anything else getting in the way. This month pray for God to show you what is getting in the way, and what you should be doing about it.

When Paul had finished speaking, he knelt down with all of them and prayed. They all wept as they embraced him and kissed him. (Acts 20:36-37)

People may be separated from us physically, but they are still joined to us in Christ: so pray for those who are away, and those whom we don't see very often any more.
