Jesus calls Levi and eats with sinners

¹³ Once again Jesus went out beside the lake. A
large crowd came to him, and he began to teach
them. ¹⁴ As he walked along, he saw Levi son of
Alphaeus sitting at the tax collector's booth. 'Follow
me', Jesus told him, and Levi got up and followed
him.

¹⁵ While Jesus was having dinner at Levi's house,
many tax collectors and sinners were eating with him
and his disciples, for there were many who followed
him. ¹⁶ When the teachers of the law who were
Pharisees saw him eating with the sinners and tax
collectors, they asked his disciples: 'Why does he
eat with tax collectors and sinners?'

¹⁷ On hearing this, Jesus said to them, 'It is not the
healthy who need a doctor, but those who are ill. I
have not come to call the righteous, but sinners.'
